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Collection LBSPA: Spanish linguistics and literature

Collection

The collection comprises ca. 15,000 volumes and covers the whole field of Spanish language and literature, from the middle ages to the present. The language and literature of the Spanish speaking countries in Middle and South-America are also represented. The collection contains the divisions linguistics and literature and a large number of dictionaries and reference works. The publications on the Spanish voyages of discovery and the historical background literature are to be found in the History collection.

Within the literature division a distinction has been made between Spanish literature (18.32) and Spanish-American literature (18.33).

The general sections contain bibliographies and reference works as well as studies on literary genres, studies on literary themes and motives, and general publications on Spanish and Spanish-American literary history. A large part of the collection has been arranged chronologically by period.

For Spanish literature the large number of works from and about the Spanish Siglo de Oro is of interest. For Spanish-American literature the focus is on the twentieth century, with works by such great authors as Borges and Neruda as well as an interesting collection of books on chicano literature.

The linguistics collection contains material specifically dealing with the Spanish language.
