

## Checklist Entry Requirements

Educational Sciences

This form is **not required** for students with a Bachelor's degree in **Educational Sciences from a Dutch research university**.

For all other students, this form is mandatory.

In the scheme below you must show to the Admissions Committee how you have acquired each competency. List relevant academic courses or other relevant academic experiences (such as internships, summer courses, thesis or extra-curricular research). For everything you list, you need to hand in evidence. You can upload supporting documents via the regular application process in Osiris Online Application.

For academic courses:

- a) The course needs to be listed on your transcript.
- b) You need to upload official course syllabi in English or Dutch (online or offline). Realise that the Admissions Committee is unfamiliar with your specific curriculum. Via course descriptions the content of a course can be verified.

For other relevant experiences, you can upload for instance:

a digital copy of your thesis or other research report.

When the Admissions Committee is unable to verify the course content or experience, it will not be taken into account in the assessment of your application file.
