JOB REQUIREMENTS U-TEAch track

To enter the U-TEAch track via the *fulltime* in-service programme:

- You need to fulfill the entrance requirements.
- You need to be teaching a minimum of 5 hours and an absolute maximum of 12 hours per week (0,5 fte) at a bilingual school or international school in the Netherlands.
 Bilingual schools are only acceptable for subjects taught in English. Ensure about half your lesson hours are in English.
- It is vital that your school provides supervision. During PiP2 it is required that you are (partly) supervised by a first degree teacher.
- You are required to attend the introductory period of one full-time week in August before the start of the academic year (for more information and dates please visit the website Intro GST).
- During the academic year, you work at school a maximum of four days each week and spend the other day at the university where you attend courses and have the opportunity to reflect on your in-school experiences.
- You need to be available to attend university courses on Mondays in semester 1 and Tuesdays in semester 2, with the flexibility in January/February to attend classes on both Mondays and Tuesdays.
- Optional: You have the possibility to go abroad for a short period during the second part of the course as well as continuing to work at your own school.

For those doing the *parttime* in-service programme the requirements above apply, however:

- You are allowed to teach a maximum of 0,8 fte instead of 0,5 fte. However, we strongly advise to teach a maximum of 0,7 fte.
- You need to be available to attend university courses on Mondays in year 1 *and* in semester 1 of year 2; in semester 2 of year 2 you need to be available to attend university courses on Tuesdays, with the flexibility in January/February to attend classes on both Mondays and Tuesdays.
