For all other students, this form is mandatory.

This Master's programme has a methodology and statistics requirement. In order to verify whether you have the required knowledge, please list all relevant academic courses you have passed / will pass in this field.

Please note:

- a) a course needs to be listed on your transcript or in the overview of courses yet to be completed
- b) For every course you list, you need to upload (a web link to) official course syllabi in English or Dutch.

Realise that the Admissions Committee is unfamiliar with your specific curriculum. Via course syllabi the content of a course can be verified.

In case the Admissions Committee is unable to verify the course content or experience, it will not be taken into account in the assessment of your application file.

1. Undergraduate training in methods and statistics,
including topics such as univariate descriptive statistics, correlation, univariate regression, and one-way analysis of variance.

2. Training in one or more topics in multivariate statistics,
Such as multiple regression, and/or multiple analysis of variance (manova, mancova).
