Which forms of financial support are available for new diversity networks?

A starting diversity network can, in consultation with the <u>Diversity Network Coordinator</u>, apply for start funding for:

- the organising of activities during the first year.
- the organising of the starting network (compensation).

Available funding

For every starting network, a total fund of € 4,000 is available. A number of <u>criteria</u> have to be met in order to be eligible for this start funding.

The financial support can be used for the organising of activities, but also as a form of compensation for the time and energy students and staff members put into the network. Some examples are:

- actions taken by interns, student assistants or participation-staff members;
- volunteers' fees
- compensation within a current position (2h/w).
