## How can you provide input for policy as a diversity network?

A diversity network usually represents specific interests of one or more diversity groups. The goal is to improve the well-being, opportunities and possibilities of such groups within Utrecht University. Throughout the year, three moments are organised in which a network can provide input:

- Two half-yearly meetings of the diversity network with the <u>Diversity Network Coordinator</u>
- The annual All Diversity Networks Meeting

Every year, the <u>Diversity Network Coordinator</u> presents the state of affairs in the <u>EDI Steering Group</u> and discusses the points of attention. This way, we ensure that current matters receive the attention they deserve.

## Additional attention by organising an activity

The organisation of <u>an activity</u> within one of the Diversity Months of Utrecht University (March and October) helps to direct attention to a subject and ask for additional attention for it.

Of course, it is allowed to provide requested and unrequested advice to the EDI Office via the Diversity Network Coordinator throughout the year.
