



Diploma statement

Even if you did not obtain your diploma yet, you can still already submit your application.

In this case, however, we will need written proof that you are indeed in the final year of secondary school, and that it is likely that you will graduate soon. For this, you can ask your school to write a formal statement.

This statement must contain the following information:

- Your name
- Your date of birth
- The official and full name of the diploma you will be obtaining (both in English and the original name, if applicable)
- The subjects you will take your exams in, and the level/type of the exams if applicable
- Expected graduation date
- The name and position of the person signing the statement

The statement must be signed and stamped by an official at your school.
